What do you think of when you think about Easter? Now imagine Easter for the 99 per cent of people in Mongolia who have never heard or grasped that Jesus died for them.

Life in Mongolia is far from easy. Rural nomadic families are left on the margins, struggling with dark winters, plummeting temperatures, mass unemployment and catastrophic weather events known as the 'white death'. Traditional animistic worship is rife, and alcoholism is common.

Baska, and his pastor, Oggii, are two Mongolian church planters ready to reach rural families with the good news of Jesus. After the winter snow melts, Baska hopes to re-open a greenhouse project launched last year, with the hope of reaching more rural families. Our giving will support Baska to host this and other outreach events that share the gospel with nomadic communities.

This Easter, let's take this opportunity to stand alongside the global Church, sharing Jesus' love, planting churches and fulfilling the Great Commission. Let's play our part in seeing people from every tribe, tongue and nation worshipping before God's throne of grace!
